Workshop Description:

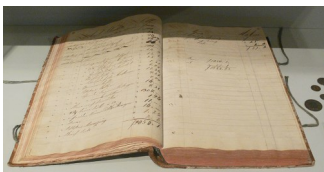
This workshop will address the types of information that can be found in land records and how that information can provide a gold mine of clues to enhance your genealogical research efforts.
