

**Ingham County Genealogical Society**  
**October 14, 2010**

The October 14, 2010, regular meeting of the Ingham County Genealogical Society was held at the Vevay Township Hall. President Dave Held called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. There were 36 people in attendance, including 3 guests.

**PROGRAM:** Diane Bishop, ICGS Librarian, presented a program entitled "Researching at the Ingham County Genealogical Society Library."

**BUSINESS MEETING:** After a break, the business meeting began at 7:59 p.m.

**INSTALLATION OF 2010-11 ICGS OFFICERS;** John Castle administered the oath of office to the officers elected for 2010-2011: President, Grove Sandrock; Vice President, Robyn Sheely; Treasurer, Bill Carr; Recording Secretary, Beth Hall; Membership Secretary; Cathy Morse; Librarian, Diane Bishop; and Trustee, Rod Jewett. Trustee Sara Price was absent.

**MINUTES:** Sam Pardee moved to accept the minutes of the September 2, 2010, meeting. The minutes were approved as submitted.

**OFFICER REPORTS:** President Grove Sandrock announced he will leave the position of Fund Raising Chair vacant unless there is a fund raising project. He will send out agendas to members via e-mail if they so request. Vice President Robyn Sheely said Shirley Hodges will be the speaker at the November 11 meeting. Treasurer Bill Carr noted income has dropped a little, but ICGS expenditures were less than income in 2009-2010. Dave Held moved to accept the treasurer's report. The treasurer's report was accepted as submitted. Grove Sandrock noted 25% of ICGS members do not live in Ingham County. Librarian Diane Bishop asked for volunteers to assist at the library.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS:** Grove Sandrock said Cindy Hawkins is preparing the October newsletter. Historian Alice Raatz said the history book is up to date. Publicity Chair Dave Held asked for suggestions on expanding publicity coverage. Michigan Genealogical Council Delegate Sam Pardee reported on the changes at the Library of Michigan and asked members to wear a green ribbon when at the library to designate they are genealogy researchers. The council will present a program on genealogy on October 30. See the council web site for details. John Castle noted some genealogy books are available for the taking at the meeting.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:** Grove Sandrock said that money that was approved for moving items at the Library of Michigan has not been spent, and probably won't be needed.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Dave Held reported that when the Executive Board met recently, it approved a budget for the current year and discussed possible fund raising.

**ANNOUNCEMENT AND ADJOURNMENT:** Norm Osborn said Family Tree Maker will soon be available for Apple computers. Grove Sandrock said the next general meeting will be on November 11, 2010.
